Charging Management - Plan and follow up charging in Volvo Connect

Volvo Connect is one single interface for fleets and businesses where vehicles, trailers and all other assets of importance can be managed.

Vehicle charged and ready for the next mission

Charging Management provides a visual overview of the truck fleet's battery level and charging status. Vehicles that need attention are highlighted with actionable information.

User-defined charging plans determine when vehicles are expected to start charging and reach full battery levels. Deviations to the plan are notified to the user in order to mitigate low battery level.

A set of Volvo supported chargers can be added to Volvo Connect to manage settings and monitor status.

Charging session reports on vehicles as well as chargers are available for follow-up.



PRODUCTIVITY

- Ensures that the trucks within a fleet are sufficiently charged for planned operations.



UPTIME

- Reduces the number of unplanned charging sessions.
- Potential charging faults are detected early, to ensure uninterrupted operation.
