Use Instructions	 Roadcrew Heavy Duty TFR should be diluted 4:1 prior to dosing into your pressure washer. Diluted product can be used hot or cold in the normal way via a pressure washer. For best results use hot. Apply the solution to the surface of the vehicle at low or high pressure working from the bottom of the vehicle upward to avoid cleaning-streaks over dry areas of the vehicle. In hot weather cool paintwork with water before applying chemical. Do not allow the chemical to dry on the surface. Rinse with a bucket, hose or pressure washer from the top of the vehicle rinsing downwards evenly and methodically.
Hints & Tips	For a perfect spot-free finish dry with a squeegee or chamois. For the very best results, use warm water (<60°C at machine). To avoid cleaning-streaks, always work from bottom to top of vehicle.
Precautions	Always observe precautions in material safety data sheet. For fresh or damaged paint/livery always check compatibility on an inconspicuous area first.
